

Hostos-Lincoln Academy of Science (HLAS) is a NYC Department of Education (DOE) public school located in the South Bronx. HLAS was converted into an early college high school in 2004 and now serves students in grades 6 through 12. Formerly situated on the Hostos Community College campus, HLAS is now co-located with other schools in a DOE building. HLAS includes a college preparatory curriculum beginning in middle school and culminates with college course-taking in high school.

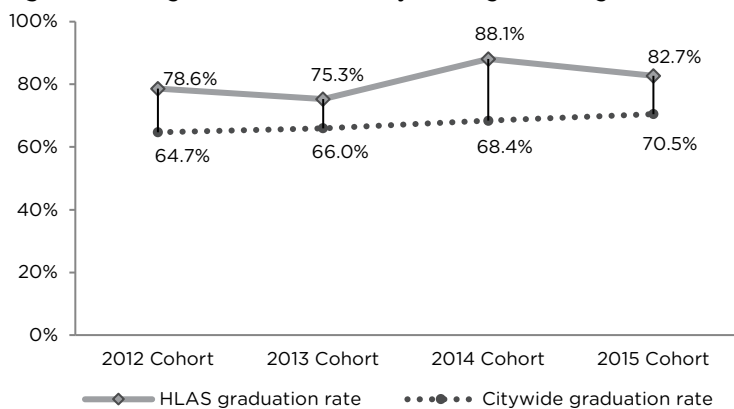

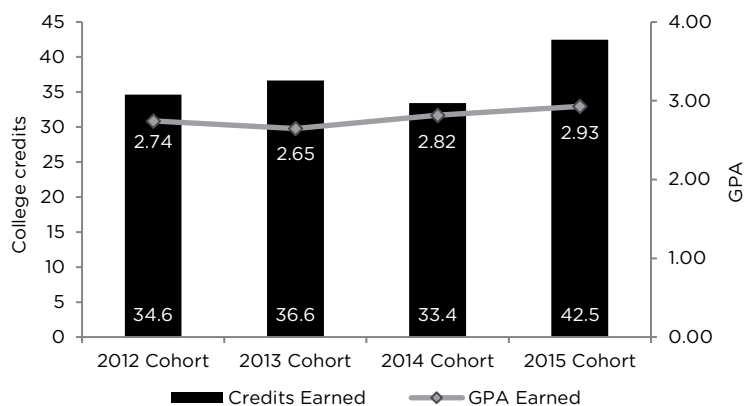

**Figure 1.** HLAS graduation rate vs. citywide high school graduation rate<sup>2</sup>

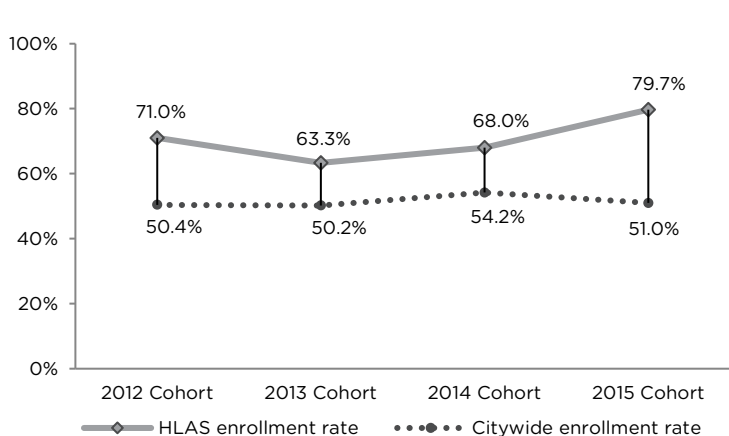


**Figure 2.** Average college GPA and college credits of graduates

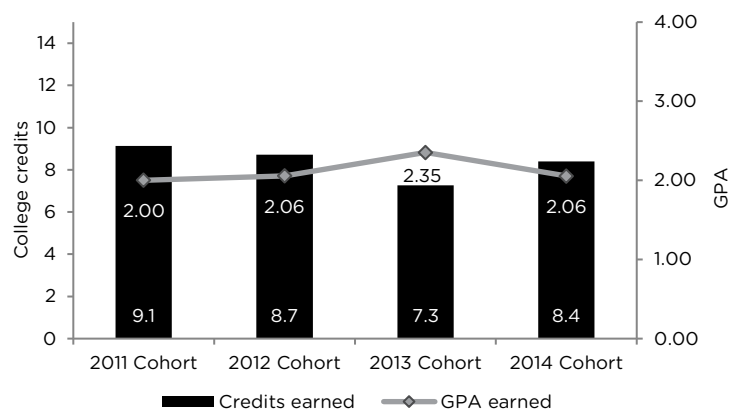
