

International High School at LaGuardia (IHS) is a NYC Department of Education (DOE) public school located in Long Island City, Queens on the LaGuardia Community College (LaGuardia) campus. IHS is co-located with another early college school, Middle College High School at LaGuardia (MCHS) both serving students in grades 9 through 12, and offers students the option of remaining for a 5th year to continue earning credits towards an associate degree. Founded in 1985, IHS mostly serves recent immigrants to the U.S. with varying degrees of English proficiency.

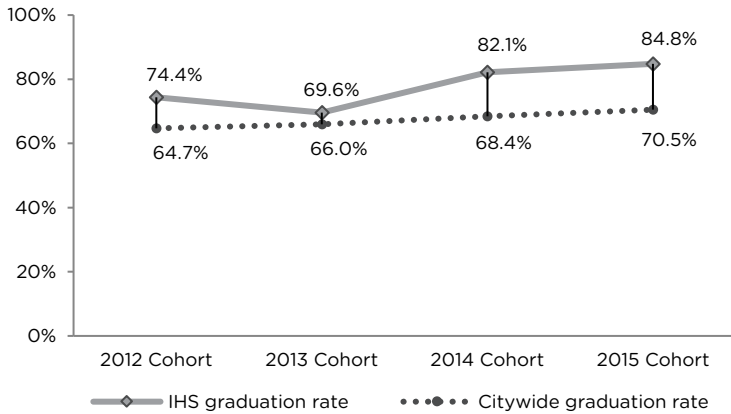

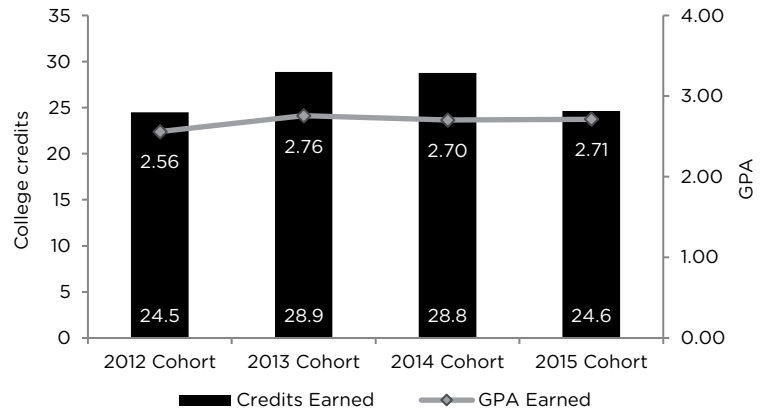

**Figure 1. IHS graduation rate vs. citywide high school graduation rate<sup>2</sup>**

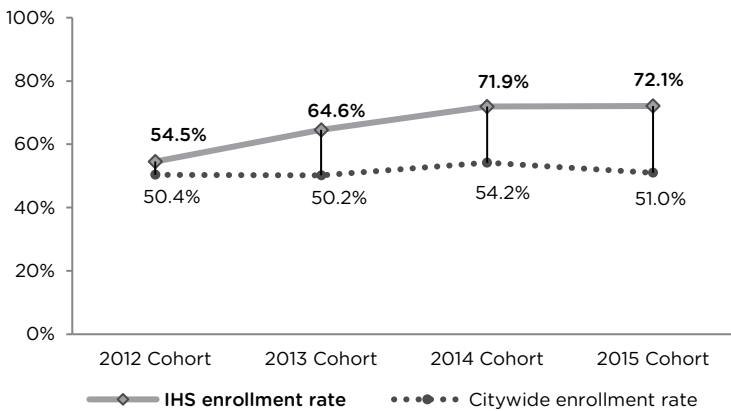


**Figure 2. Average college GPA and college credits of graduates**

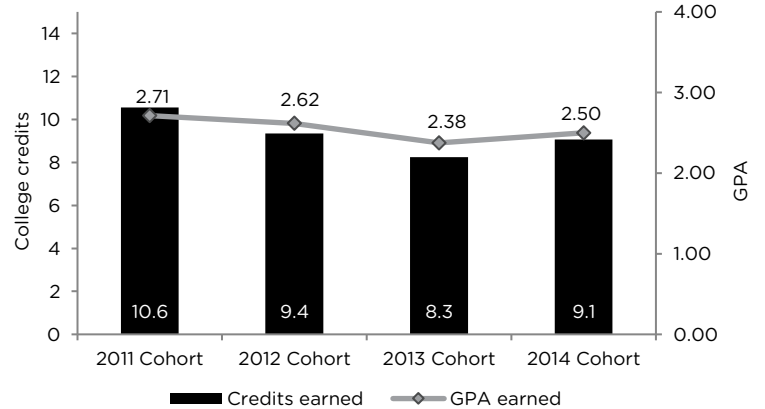
