HLAS was converted into an early college high school in 2004 and now serves students in grades 6 through 12. Formerly situated on the Hostos Community College campus, HLAS is now co-located with other schools in a DOE building. HLAS includes a college preparatory curriculum beginning in middle school and culminates with college course-taking in high school.





Academic Outcomes in High School: 2013-2016 Graduating Cohorts


Figure 1. HLAS graduation rate vs. citywide high school graduation rate²






Postsecondary Enrollment and Outcomes: 2013-2016 Graduating Cohorts
