

Kingsborough Early College Secondary School (KECSS) is a NYC Department of Education (DOE) public school located in the Manhattan Beach section of Brooklyn, New York. KECSS serves students in the 6th through 12th grades and offers students college preparatory curriculum which begins in middle school and culminates with college course-taking in high school. This ECI model affords students the opportunity to earn both a high school diploma and an associate degree (or up to two years of transferable credit) upon graduation.

Figure 1. KECSS graduation rate vs. citywide high school graduation rate²

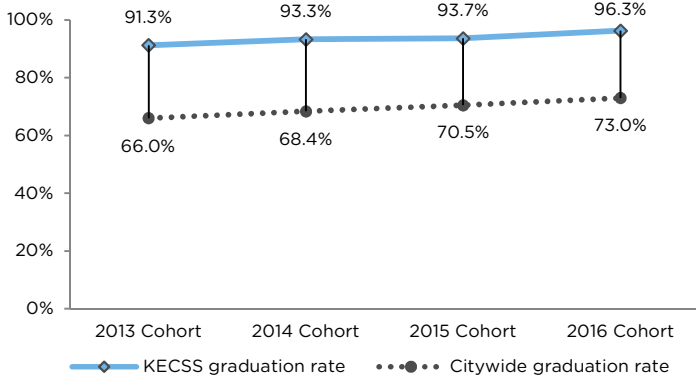
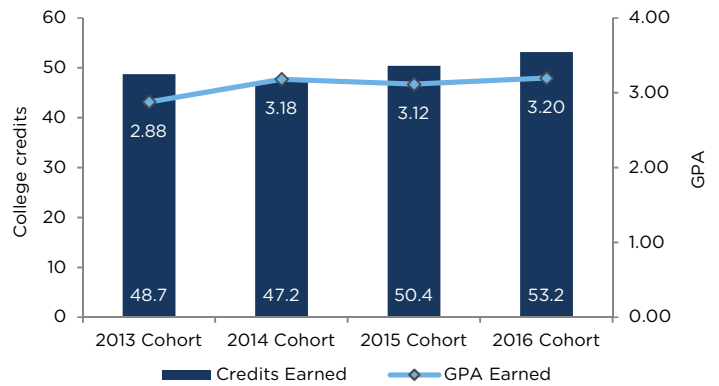


Figure 2. Average college GPA and college credits of graduates

Figure 3. KECSS graduates vs. citywide college 6-month enrollment rate^{2,3,4,5}

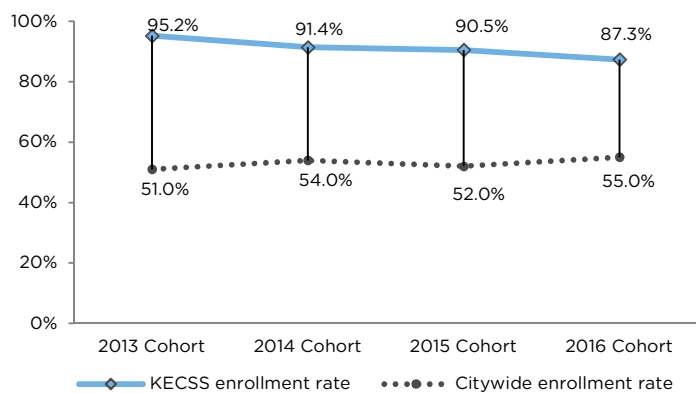
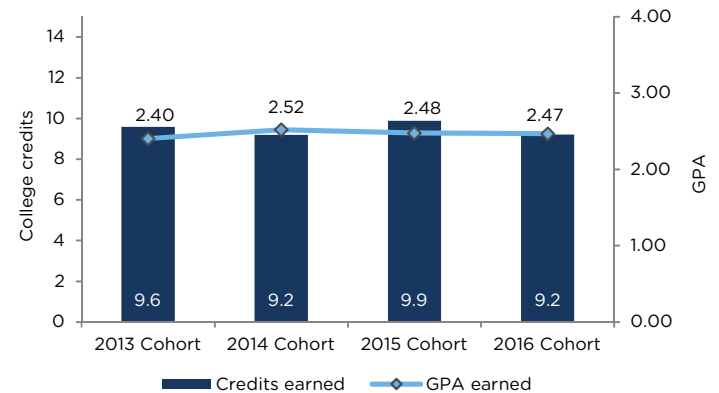


Figure 4. KECSS graduates' average Fall semester college GPA and credits⁶
